# Cactus Pet Rocks



Materials needed:

1. Rocks - Select them based on the size of your terra cotta pot.
2. Outdoor Acrylic paint - green and white
3. Mini TerraCotta Pots
4. 2-3 Paint brushes
5. Sand

Directions:

1. Clean your rocks and make sure they are dry.
2. Paint your rocks to your heart's desire! We did 2 coats of green to make sure we got complete coverage.
3. After your green coat is dry, you can paint cactus designs using white paint. We used dots, lines and hash marks.
4. While waiting for it to dry, rip a piece of tape and tape the bottom of the terra cotta pot if there is a hole.
5. Pour sand into the pot. Depending on how big your rock is, the amount of sand needed may vary. Now they are ready to be placed in their new home!
6. Your done! Say hi to your new Cactus pet!
