



DIY:

Chicken Windsock



Materials:

1. Scissors
2. Orange tissue paper
3. Pen or marker
4. Tape
5. A sheet of yellow construction paper
6. A sheet of orange construction paper
7. Glue
8. Toilet Paper Roll

Directions:

1. Cut the yellow construction paper to the length of the toilet roll.
2. Tape the toilet roll to the short end of the paper and coil the paper around, until the two ends of paper meet (trim paper if extra).
3. Tape the paper shut.
4. Cut three small triangles from the orange tissue paper and glue them to the top of the toilet roll (point of triangles face down).



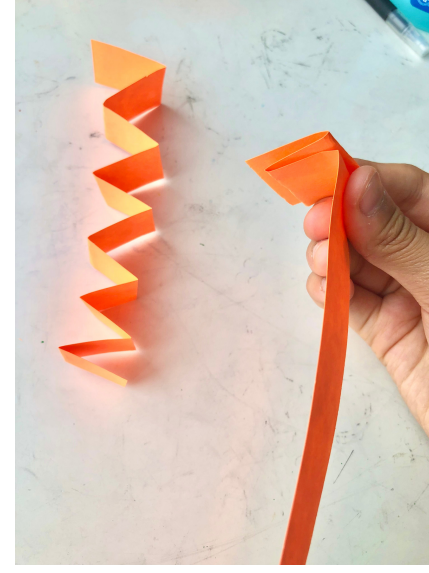

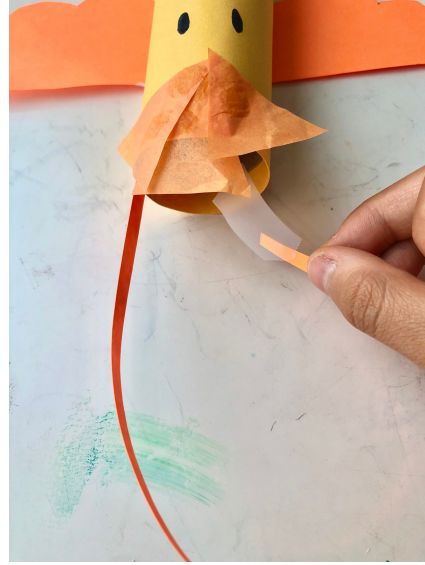
Chicken Windsock continued...



5. Cut two wing shapes and a tiny triangle (the beak!) from the orange construction paper.
6. Glue the tiny triangle (beak) to the front of the toilet roll and draw two eyes above it.
7. Tape the wings to the back.
8. Cut two strips of orange paper and fold back and forth (like an accordion!)



9. Tape the accordion-folded strips to the bottom inside of the toilet roll.
10. Cut a super thin strip and tape each end to the top (inside of the toilet roll). Now you have your very own chicken windsock!
